

MyUSPS Login Information

MyUSPS is District 9's secure members' area on the website. All active members of District 9 are able to login to view secure files, access the member roster, and use any MyUSPS applications they are authorized to use.

Logging in to MyUSPS is extremely simple. When it was created, the MyUSPS login system was based on National's Certificate/ZIP login check, so that all members would login the same way on National's site as in MyUSPS. Eventually, National updated its login system to require a password to login.

Because National keeps your password secure, **MyUSPS cannot access your National password**. MyUSPS has its own password database to allow for the increased security that passwords provide over ZIP codes.

Here's the important part: **You are in complete control of your MyUSPS password.**

If you have not set a password in MyUSPS, you can login using:

- your **5-digit ZIP code** (United States)
- your **6-character Postal Code without a space** (Canada)

Every effort has been made to ensure that the website recognizes the way Canadian addresses are sometimes stored in DB2000, so Postal Codes should work properly to allow you to login.

If...

- Your ZIP code / Postal Code does not allow you to login,
- You're using the one that is on file at HQ (in DB2000), and
- You didn't type it incorrectly or add extra characters

Then **you have already chosen a password within MyUSPS** at some point!

Don't remember your password? Don't worry!

Just go to <http://myusps.d9-usps.org/?forgot>, enter your Certificate number, and hit the "Recover" button. (That link is also available below the "Login" button on the login page.)

An email will be sent to **your email address on file at HQ** containing a link to reset your password. Just click the link, enter your new password in both boxes, and click "Reset PIN"

You can make your password whatever you want, including your National password, if you would like.

And you don't have to worry about your password being stolen: All MyUSPS passwords are stored securely, so that no one can **ever** read them.
